Application General Policies & Procedures

Requirements

- Items offered for sale must be at least 50% handmade or recycled. Items not “arts & crafts” related are not acceptable.

Registration

- Application must be signed and completed in full. Submit with full payment and photos, which will not be returned. No application will be accepted without the complete application package.
- Acceptance is determined by the Apple Harvest Celebration Planning Team; submission of an application does not guarantee a space. The Planning Team reserves the right to decline applications based on the proposed items, and to refuse admittance to anyone whose work is deemed offensive or of questionable taste.
- Only approved art, craft and food may be displayed and sold.

Confirmation

- Once your application has been approved, we will send you an email.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

- There is no rain date and no refund in case of inclement weather. Applicants who are not selected to participate will receive full refunds.
- “No Shows” who do not notify the orchard by phone or email prior to Apple Harvest Celebration day will not be considered for future applications. In case of emergency call the Showalter’s Orchard and leave a detailed message (please include the name of your business).
- Space assignments, festival map and set-up procedures will be emailed after Oct. 10.
- Each exhibitor must provide his/her own display. Canopies are not required but are recommended and must be stabilized with weights. We ask each exhibitor to take appropriate measures to make your space and its surroundings as safe as possible.

Setup

- The festival begins at 10 a.m. and ends at 5 p.m.
- Setup begins at 7 a.m. and must be completed by 9:30 a.m. All vehicles must be parked in the designated vendor parking area by 8:30 a.m.
- Please refrain from packing your booth until after 5 p.m.

Cleanup:

Remove all trash, cardboard and zip ties/plastic ties.

Showalter’s Orchard has exclusive rights to sell fresh apples and cider. Food vendors are encouraged to offer apple products and other products related to the fall harvest!
